

Welcome to the 3/4 Grade Team!

I am so excited to be working with your child this year. As you will see in your letter from Mrs. Pietz, your child has been assigned to my classroom for the upcoming school year. This class will still combine third and fourth graders, but will reduce transitions by not switching for math and language arts. Our classroom "family" will be a part of the larger 3/4 community in other ways throughout the year.

Below you will find a recommended list of school supplies. Some items, such as pencils, need to be replenished weekly. Your child should let you know when other supplies are needed. Supplies can be brought to school on August 27th, the first day of school, or at Open House.

Grade 3/4 - School Supplies

- ◆ a small pencil box or pouch
- ◆ scissors
- ◆ plastic 12-inch ruler (with in and cm scales)
- ◆ 2 glue sticks
- ◆ box of 8 or 16 crayons
- ◆ box of colored pencils
- ◆ 1 dozen sharpened Dixon Ticonderoga yellow #2 pencils (write initials in permanent marker near eraser)
- ◆ pink Pearl wedge eraser
- ◆ pencil/crayon sharpener (one that holds the shavings)
- ◆ 3 marble cover style composition books (notebook lined)
- ◆ 1 twin pocket plastic folder (for home-school communications)
- ◆ 3 Expo or dry-erase markers
- ◆ 1 yellow and 1 green highlighter
- ◆ 1 package 3x5 index cards (100)

Community Shared Materials

- ◆ 1 package of Post-It or other sticky notes
- ◆ fine tipped markers
- ◆ extra #2 pencils
- ◆ 2 extra twin pocket folders
- ◆ anti-bacterial cleaning wipes
- ◆ box of tissues
